**Binding off when Knitting:** When binding off, use a crochet hook as your right needle. It allows you to simply draw the last stitch through the next-to-last stitch using the hook, rather than using the two knitting needles. It works perfectly, and it doesn't stretch out the stitches at all like sometimes happens when you use the two knitting needles.
