Please RSVP for Make a Blanket Day, April 24, 2010—space is limited. **The theme for Make a Blanket Day is "Go Fly a Kite."**

We have just completed the figures for 2009 and the newsletter should be ready next week. We took in 1,723 blankets in 2009 and distributed 1,277. We have 186 active Blanketeers—that means we average 9.26 blankets per blanketeer! You ladies rock! For our three years as a chapter we have collected a total of 4,226 blankets and distributed 3,136.

A few important reminders: 1) Please do NOT use any type of nylon/filament thread—this poses a danger to children. 2) When tying blankets, please make sure your ties are hand-width apart—if they are further apart the batting could come loose and leave a blanket that isn't in the best of shape.
