Please RSVP for Make a Blanket Day, April 24, 2010—space is limited. The theme for Make a Blanket Day is "Go Fly a Kite." Please remember to turn in your challenge quilts by the 31st of March.

First of many things to bring for Make a Blanket Day:

1. 10 1/2 squares of transportation fabric—for every ten squares your bring you will be entered into a special drawing—they can be the same or different.

Weekly Quilting Tip - cutting out lots of pieces to sew blocks together? Buy yourself a box of the zipper close plastic food bags and sort your pieces by blocks or by shape and mark the bag! If you write on masking tape and then put the masking tape on the bag, you can reuse the bag over and over. By sorting everything - especially if you don't have a dedicated sewing area - you can quickly and easily find what you're looking for and it's easier to pick up when you have to put everything away.
