What to bring for Make a Blanket Day:

1. 10-1/2 inch squares of transportation fabric—for every ten squares you bring you will be entered into a special drawing—they can be the same or different.

2. You will need a minimum of (48) two-inch squares, the brighter the better. We will display them on a table and you can pick and choose what you want to use.

3. You will need (12) 8-inch squares of very bright fabric. Again, we will display them on a table and you can pick and choose what you want to use.

**Weekly Quilting Tip** - Try using your collection of plastic and metal cookie cutters for quilting! They make great appliqué shapes and quilting designs.
