Standard Beds: (Matress sizes)

Crib 23 x 46 inches

Twin/Day bed 39 x 75 inches

Full/ Double 54 x 75 inches

Queen 60 x 80 inches

Standard King 76 x 80 inches

### What to bring for Make a Blanket Day:

1. 10-1/2 inch squares of transportation fabric—for every ten squares you bring you will be entered into a special drawing—they can be the same or different.

2. You will need a minimum of 48 two-inch squares, the brighter the better. We will display them on a table and you can pick and choose what you want to use.

3. You will need (12) 8-inch squares of very bright fabric. Again, we will display them on a table and you can pick and choose what you want to use.

4. You will need (12) 6-inch squares of very bright fabric. Again, we will display them on a table and you can pick and choose what you want to use.

5. Money—we will be voting on the challenge quilts with cash which in turn will be a fund raiser for our Chapter. We will also have fish bowl items available. And, the raffle quilt will be given away on April 24th.
