What to bring for Make a Blanket Day:

1. 10-1/2 inch squares of transportation fabric— for every ten squares you bring you will be entered into a special drawing — they can be the same or different.

2. You will need a minimum of 48 two-inch squares, the brighter the better. We will display them on a table and you can pick and choose what you want to use.

3. You will need (12) 8-inch squares of very bright fabric. Again, we will display them on a table and you can pick and choose what you want to use.

4. You will need (12) 6-inch squares of very bright fabric. Again, we will display them on a table and you can pick and choose what you want to use.

5. Money — we will be voting on the challenge quilts with cash which in turn will be a fund raiser for our Chapter. We will also have fish bowl items available. And, the raffle quilt will be given away on April 24th.

6. We will be having Friendship Salad for lunch. We will provide the greens and we ask each of you to bring your favorite topping — dressing, tomatoes, onions, cucumbers, olives, cheese, meat, croutons, etc.
