**Tip of the Week:** If you are cutting the same size cut of fabric multiple times, do yourself a favor and mark the correct cutting line on your ruler with blue painters tape. Place the tape right next to the line you are going to line the edge of your fabric with, not on top of it, it will distort the line. By doing this, you're eye is easily drawn to the correct line and you'll have fewer cutting mistakes and it speeds up your cutting!
